



Buildings and Estates of Purley on Thames **Westfield**

Westfield was a large brick house which stood to the west of Purley Lane about where Nursery Gardens now stands.

It was converted into flats in the 1960s and demolished around 1970 to make way for the development at the east end of Nursery Gardens.

The driveway came out onto the main road just after the junction with Purley Lane and here were constructed two cottages one of which was occupied by the coachman. On the 29th August 1915 Harry Jarman the son of the coachman to Lady Sykes died of his wounds while serving with the Berkshire Yeomanry

in 1943 the house was taken over by the examinations department of the Royal Society of Arts.
